



Duty of Care Statement for the Parish Religious Education Program


The Parish of Saints John and Paul, Willetton, has a duty of care to children attending the After School Parish Religious Education Program @ the Parish Centre.

Your child's safety and well being are most important, and we seek your support and cooperation

We advise you therefore, that:

- Classes commence at 4pm and finish at 5pm.
- Supervision will be provided for **ten minutes before and ten minutes after classes.**
- All children must be dropped off and picked up promptly within these times. **It is the responsibility of parents to drop off and pick up their child/ren.**
- Children will need to be dropped off to the church @ Sts John & Paul Parish, Pinetree Gully Road, Willetton and picked from the class area or the grassed area in order to ensure their safety.
- Should you arrive before 3.50pm, it is your responsibility to supervise your child/ren.
- If you are delayed in picking up your child/ren, then you should make alternative arrangements or contact us.
- As a safety precaution, please follow the signs on the parish grounds and do not stop to drop off/pick up on the run. All children must be collected by an adult and they will not be permitted to walk to the car in the car park.
- Our Parish Catechist are Volunteers and deserve respect and co-operation at all times.
- Your child/ren's photo may be taken at special events or in the classroom and this will be used to inform the Catechists Services Team @ the Catholic Education Office or displayed on the Parish Notice Board and Parish Website.
